## BVA Card Party Update

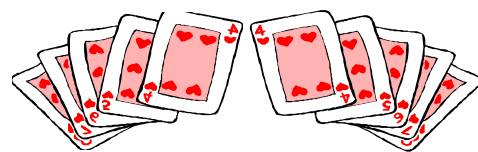
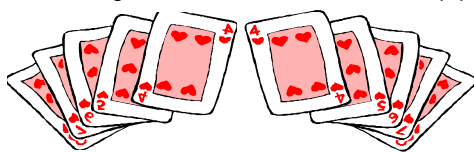
