Available Housing Options

Conrad House

(Est. 1972)

Enjoy independent living in our eight-story high rise, Conrad House. Residents can choose from spacious studio, or small and large one bedroom apartments. Features include: breathtaking lakefront property, 24-hour emergency assistance, secure locked entry, Brevillier Village Convenience Store, and active Resident Council. Additional amenities include meal plans & Home Care Services*

Barnabas Court South & North

(South Est. 1986 & North Est. 1998)

Residents have the option to explore independent living in a studio, or one and two bedroom apartments. Partial or full personal care services are also available and include: three meals each day, housekeeping, laundry, assistance with medication, personal hygiene care and ambulation, 24-hour nursing services within a secure building.



Health Care Services

Ball Pavilion

(Est. 1977, 1998)

Long term skilled nursing care with 24-hour nursing services, individualized care plans, person-centered care, physician, dietitian consultations. Private rooms with hospice services are available for residents and families experiencing their end of life journey.

Short term skilled nursing care provide residents with the rehabilitation resources needed to recuperate and return home. Brand new private rooms provide the comfort and peace to heal. Our Rehabilitation Suite incorporates diverse therapies based on individual needs.

Non-resident treatment rehabilitation options are also available for outpatient therapy.

Residents are welcome to enjoy a variety of services including on-site barber & stylist, rehabilitation services, dental, podiatry, psychological, optometry, and audiology services, social services, recreational activities and outings, wheelchair accessible transportation, chaplain and religious services, two on-site chapels, convenience store, Haven Program (pets, gardens and intergenerational programs), large print library, and guest room accommodations for visiting family and friends.



Home Care Program

Residents and local community members may inquire about receiving in home care which provides assistance with meals, personal care, medication reminders, light housekeeping, laundry, shopping and errands to maximize independence for as long as possible.



Share Care Program

Contact us for more information about our off-campus residential properties, with a personal care aide on-site (24/7) to assist with daily living activities. PA Waiver or private pay options are available for Share Care residents.
