

## Brevillier Village COVID-19 Update – December 29th, 2020

As we are closing out this highly unusual year, we do so with a bit of good news.

Residents of Ball Pavilion and all Brevillier Village staff who want the COVID-19 vaccine will receive their first shot on Wednesday, January 6, 2021. The second shots will be January 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

Walgreens will be on site the entire day to give vaccinations. We are scheduled to receive the Pfizer vaccine.

Any Brevillier staff and Ball Pavilion resident who wants vaccinated this day will need to have their consent forms returned to any office by Sunday January 3<sup>rd</sup>,2021. This is important as we must upload all information to the Walgreen's portal before the end of day on January 4<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

We will also be sending out the Barnabas Court consent forms later this week as personal care residents are scheduled to be given their vaccines after the first round of shots are complete. But if you want the vaccine please get the forms back asap as you never know if they will move these dates forward.

At this time, we still have not received any guidance on independent facilities like Conrad House. Our state association, leading age pa is leading the way in trying to find out when vaccine will be available.

The one thing the federal and state governments have made very clear is that any nursing home resident or staff member of Brevillier Village who does not get the vaccine in this first round – there is no guarantee when the vaccine would be available to you. They have told us it could be summer before you would have access to a vaccine again.

I continue to say that this is a very fluid process and things are changing daily.
