We are in the Midst of Some Light and Hopefully Getting Closer to the end of the COVID Tunnel

Brevillier Village has maintained a very cautious approach to COVID since the beginning of the Pandemic. As we are beginning to see areas where we can relax some of our strategies, we are doing so.

Caution still remains the premise as we make new decisions about visitation, testing, wearing of PPE, traveling, etc. We are being optimistic, but realize we serve a variety of residents from very healthy and independent to very frail and with many illnesses and needs. Trying to juggle the different residents and their different needs can be very tricky to say the least. We are trying to make decisions based on those particular residents and their particular needs. But we also must be careful as we are a community with many paths that cross. Visitors sometimes have family in multiple buildings, staff may need to provide care in multiple facilities even though we have tried to eliminate that as much as possible.



Some decisions we have some flexibility with and others are mandated by a government agency whether it be federal, state or local entities.

One of the new regulations is that we need to educate residents, families and staff on the Advantages and Risks of taking the vaccine. In the next several

weeks, we will be sending an article to all residents, staff and families to meet this obligation for the brand new federal regulation for skilled nursing facilities. We have been very lucky that we still maintain about a 94% vaccination rate for residents throughout all buildings. We have also seen an increase in staff vaccinations from about 44% to almost 60%. If any residents or staff want the vaccination please make sure to contact us and we can make that happen.

- Technology Install Fees waived for new admissions at BCN and BCS




