
Family Volunteers

Recreation Update

Hello everyone, if you have not been on our website, here is a little insight on how recreation has been providing entertainment and activities with your loved ones. To best protect residents and staff we are still following necessary COVID-19 precautions and restrictions. Activities may vary based on these restrictions.

GREEN – Residents can enjoy a variety of activities with recreation staff each day. Groups are limited to 10 or less, one on one in resident room, and now that the weather is cooperating, you may find us outside. We can offer the beverage and snack cart during the afternoons. Lunch from local restaurants is also on our agenda. We mindfully practice social distancing in all recreation activities.

YELLOW - Neighborhood activities are offered each day. One on ones take place in the resident's room. Activity bags for residents to do at their leisure are created and delivered to the rooms of those who do not require help. We love to be outside on the nice days. Beverage cart offered at virtually every activity & in room visits.

RED - These rooms are restricted to keep everyone in the Village Neighborhood safe and least exposed to potential COVID exposer. COVID Restricted staff are provided with adequate PPE and can complete one on one activities with residents and are also provided with tv's if desired/needed.
