## **Visitation Protocols for Barnabas Court**

## March 17, 2021

## PLEASE CALL TO SCHEDULE A VISIT

The Barnabas Court conference room will be converted into a visitation station for BC North.

The Recreation Room inside the Main entrance of South will be used for BC South visitation.

The dividers will be placed appropriately for required social distancing.

Barnabas Court will have visitation Monday through Friday from 10 am until 3 pm.

Saturdays will be from 10:00 am until 2:00 pm.

There are no Sunday visits at Barnabas Court.

First two weeks will be 30-minute visits. Starting April 1<sup>st,</sup> we will convert to 15-minute visits.

- If resident has <u>not</u> been FULLY vaccinated, they will wear full PPE.
- If resident is FULLY vaccinated, they will only wear blue masks.
- If visitor is FULLY vaccinated, they will wear blue mask & gloves, they are not required to wear the gowns.
- If the visitors are NOT 2 weeks out from the completion of the vaccination or unable to show proof of vaccination, they will wear full PPE: gloves, gowns, and masks.
- Families will wear the masks provided at Brevillier Village.
- Rooms/furniture will be cleaned in-between visits.
- Visitation for Hospice will remain at 1 family member once a day for up to 1 hour. Visitors must stay in resident room at all time. Hospice visits cannot happen if resident is on isolation or quarantine.
- End of Life visits will be open ended and no more than 4 visitors in the room at one time.
- Skype, Face time, and window visits will continue.
- Outdoor visits will start again as soon as the weather permits.

## \*\* Each resident may only have one visit per day, not multiple visits on the same day. Visitors will remain at 2 per visit. Age limit for children will continue to be the age of 10 years and older. \*\*

If there is a positive case of COVID among staff and or residents of Barnabas Court, then all visits would stop immediately and state protocols for re-opening to visits will be followed.

This could take up to 14 days or longer.

If you have received the 2-step vaccination, please present your card before the first scheduled visit. We will make a copy for our files.
