Please, if you have family or friends in town or have been in these areas and you have been socializing with them and not taking the precautions of masks, social distancing, etc. please do not come to the Village for even an outdoor or window visit. The only way we can keep COVID from coming to Brevillier is to be vigilant. Please complete the required 14 days of quarantine. If you or a family member or friend test positive please refrain from coming til you have a negative test or wait the 14 days. Thank you so much for your help in keeping everyone safe!
