

## Visitation Protocols for Ball Pavilion Begins March 17, 2021

### **Ball Pavilion**

The Ball Pavilion conference room will be converted into a visitation station.

The 6-foot table and plexi glass divider will be placed in there for indoor visits.

The existing conference room next to Vicky's office will be set up in the small Recreation Room.

Ball Pavilion will have visitation daily.

Monday through Friday will be from 10 am until 7 pm.

Saturdays and Sundays will be from 10 am until 3 pm.

First two weeks will be 30-minute visits. Starting April 1<sup>st</sup> we will convert to 15-minute visits.

- If resident **HAS NOT** been FULLY vaccinated, they will wear full PPE. If visitor is they will wear mask and gloves.
- If resident is vaccinated, they will only wear blue masks.
- If the visitors have the vaccination completed, they will not be required to wear the gowns.
- Families/visitors not vaccinated or unable to show proof of vaccination will continue to be required to wear gloves, gowns, and masks. Families will wear the masks provided at Brevillier Village.
- Rooms/furniture will be cleaned in-between visits.
- Visitation for Hospice will remain at 1 family member once a day for up to 1 hour. Visitors must stay in resident room at all time. Hospice visits cannot happen if resident is on isolation or quarantine.
- End of Life visits will be open ended and no more than 4 visitors in the room at one time.
- Skype, Face time, and window visits will continue.
- Outdoor visits will also begin as soon as weather permits.
- No pets will be allowed during indoor visitation.

**\*\* Each resident may only have one visit per day, not multiple visits on the same day. Visitors will remain at 2 people per visit. Age limit for children will continue to be the age of 10 years and older. \*\***

If there is a positive case of COVID among staff and or residents of Ball Pavilion, then all visits would stop immediately and state protocols for re-opening to visits will be followed.

This could take up to 14 days or longer.

If you have received the 2-step vaccination please present your card before the first scheduled visit. We will make a copy for our files.
