BARNABAS COURT **NORTH** VISITATION As of 3/10/22

- There will be no <u>time</u> limits on visits.
- Number of visitors at a time will be 4 so that social distancing can still be done in residents' rooms.
- If a larger group of family would like to come in together, or visitors for a resident with a roommate want to visit, the BCN front conference room can be used.
- There will be no restrictions on the number of visits a resident can have in a day.
- Pets can visit residents for indoor and outdoor visits. We must have updated shot records from vet and flea treatment on file for pets to visit at Brevillier Village. Please contact Marti Colliss Director of Recreation or Kayla Turk for any questions.
- For resident birthdays or special event please call to make special arrangements. The events will be limited to 6 people including resident. Call Jean LaFuria or Vickie Gilchrist to make arrangements.
- Residents and Visitors that are VACCINATED AND NON-VACCINATED will be able to be on the
 grounds for walks or visit by the front door at North or in the Courtyard in South we encourage
 ALL Visitors/Resident wear a mask.
- **INDOOR** visits must be in resident's room and not in public spaces.
- Visitors may take residents for car rides and/or visit at family member home (for less than 24 hours), they should wear masks. We do NOT encourage NON-VACCINATED visitors and NON-VACCINATED residents to a family member's home. If they do, for more than 24 hours the resident will need to quarantine for 5 days or longer if they develop symptoms.

<u>All</u> visitors must still go to Ball Pavilion to wash hands, screen, and get a mask and badge from the screening station. If guests come into Barnabas Court North <u>without</u> a badge, they will be asked to leave and go to Ball Pavilion to screen and get their badges.

All visitors are to go directly to the resident's room without spending time at the nurses' station, recreation room or visiting with other residents.

We would appreciate visitations during regular business hours:

Monday through Friday 8am until 8pm Saturdays and Sundays 9am until 4pm

We ask that everyone follow these guidelines so that all the Barnabas Court residents can remain healthy as they enjoy their visits from family and friends.

Isolation/Quarantine Guidelines for <u>BC North</u> at Brevillier Village

Updated 3/10/22

VACCINATED RESIDENTS:

Emergency Room Visits- no quarantine required unless they have been there more than 24 hours or if resident develops symptoms. If this occurs, residents will need to Quarantine for at least 7 days with a COVID test on day 5.

Residents coming from home or hospital stay on admission or readmission will be required to quarantine for 7 days with BINEX test on Day 5. If they develop symptoms their quarantine could be extended. They will ne able to have compassion visits as needed.

Residents who go to public events such as dinner at a crowded restaurant, wedding, large family event (meaning more than 4-5 people) or gathering, family home visit (over 24 hours), or traveling/vacationing etc. when they return, they are required to quarantine for 5 days with a BINEX test on day 5. Their quarantine could be extended if they begin to show any symptoms.

NON-VACCINATED RESIDENTS

NON-VACCINATED residents will quarantine for 7 days regardless of whether they are in the Emergency Room, hospital, go out to a crowded public event, funerals, go home with family (over 24 hours), etc. They will be tested on day 5 with a Nasal Swab and released on day 7 or when we receive a negative test result. They should wear masks at these types of events. They will be given compassion visits if needed.

We do not encourage residents to be in groups or with individuals who are not vaccinated, especially when experiencing COVID surges.

At any time, these new guidelines can be suspended or stopped per county, state, or federal regulations.
