CRXFT Conrad House Resident Bake & Craft Sale:



Caring Angels:

Brevillier Village has established a policy that no resident will be alone during their final moments of life. The former Caring for the Dying program will now be called Caring Angels. The Caring Angels program is a list of specially trained volunteers who are called to sit with a resident if the family is unable to be with their loved one. These volunteers understand they can be called on anytime day or night. Training will be provided. Safety Reminders:

Please make sure to sign out at the nurse's station if you are going outside to visit, either on or off campus. South residents may sign in/out in the South foyer. This helps us keep an accurate record of whereabouts, should an emergency arise. Don't forget to check back in upon your return.

Be careful around coded doors to not let any resident through unless they are accompanied by staff or a family member. Watch while entering numbers to make sure other residents aren't looking.

Residents are always welcome in the courtyards. If a trip to the grounds is requested without a family member, please let staff know so arrangements can be made to accompany the resident.

Brevillier Village Guest Room Accommodations

Two guest rooms are available at Brevillier Village. They are on the second floor at Barnabas Court South (*This is accessible by elevator*). The guest room offers affordable, comfortable accommodations allowing family members/loved ones to be closer to the resident during their stay in Erie.

Our guest room is a studio (efficiency) apartment with a full bath that includes a walk-in shower, and a kitchenette with a microwave, coffee/coffee pot, refrigerator and sink. Both are furnished with a queen size bed, nightstand, TV, love seat and chair, dinette table and chairs, and lamp. Bed linens and towels are included. An air mattress is available if needed. Toiletries need to be provided by the guest. Telephone service is available in the room. *No pets are permitted.

The costs for the Guest Room are:

- \$90.00/night-1 guest or \$95.00 using a credit card
- \$100.00/night-2 guests or \$105.00 using a credit card

Other amenities include:

- Safe for personal belongings
- On-site Chapel for meditation/prayer
- Wi-Fi connections at designated places in the Village
- Outdoor walking path around the Village
- Convenient parking
- Some of the best sunsets in the world!!
