- You may visit at your own comfort level and risk if there is COVID in the building or if your loved one is COVID
 positive.
- Number of visitors at one time should not exceed 4 if visiting in a resident room.
- Masks are no longer required indoors unless Erie County level of transmission is high. The secretary will alert you upon screening if a mask is needed. If there is COVID in the building, masks would also be required.
- Visiting spaces are available on a first come first served basis. However, living rooms may be booked again for special occasions by calling Marti Colliss. We encourage you to keep your party to 10 or less to allow distancing.
- Visits in semi-private rooms with roommates are permitted. Please try to distance yourself from roommate. Masks are recommended if roommate is present.
- Residents may have a visitor attend an indoor recreation event with them. We ask that you distance from other residents.
- For resident birthdays or special event please call to make arrangements. The events will be limited to 10 people including resident.
- Visitors may take residents for car rides and/or visits at family member homes (for less than 24 hours). If they
 are out more than 24 hours or in a large group they will quarantine for 5 days or longer if they develop
 symptoms and will be tested on day 5.

Please continue the screening process which includes hand sanitizer and using the screening kiosk.
