## TECHNOLOGY CHANGES AT BARNABAS COURT

You may have noticed some changes at Barnabas Court! There is a brand-new nurse call system in place, and along with that, an update to our keypad system for all our locked doors. Visitors still have access to enter the "code" posted outside of each locked door to release and open the door.

As always, please be very cautious of any residents that may be close to the exit doors. Barnabas Court North is a licensed, secure dementia unit, and we need to be vigilant not to let anyone outside without proper supervision.

The new nurse call system is the first update at Barnabas since the original system was installed many years ago! So, we are very excited and thankful for everyone who made donations to make this possible!

Also, you will notice that the Personal Care Aides will now be carrying a smart phone. These phones are how they are alerted when a call bell is pulled in a resident's room. There will still be a light that flashes at each door, too, so any other staff person can help when a resident is in need. The PCA's will be able to call or text each other for help, or to notify coworkers when they are unavailable. The Nurse, Director of Nursing, and myself also receive alerts to our computers. These smart phones work ONLY with the new system, not the internet or streaming services.

Everything that has been updated is to ensure our residents are being taken care of promptly and efficiently. Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns. Feel free to stop by my office at North or send an email to <u>vgilchrist@brevillier.org</u>.
